2017 UPCE Scholarship Program

Good day members of the UPCE,

The Union of Postal Communications Employees "UPCE" has created its own scholarship program for UPCE members and their children. This is in addition to any existing Public Service Alliance of Canada "PSAC" scholarships that may be available.

And the \$2,000 UPCE Scholarship Program, is available to all UPCE members in good standing (and their children), who are enrolled at a post-secondary institution.

Program Guidelines

The UPCE will accept submissions from May 01, 2017, until July 31, 2017. All the recipients should receive notification of the award no later than September 30, 2017.

A \$2,000 scholarship will be available to a member (or a child of a member) enrolled in a full-time, yearlong program. A member (or their child) enrolled in a part-time or half-year program, will only be entitled to half of the scholarship (\$1,000). In a case like this, the second half of the scholarship (\$1,000) will be disbursed to the second place applicant.

The scholarship will be awarded based on the merit of a 500-word essay, video, or collection of original photos, as it relates to the application topic chosen for the given year.

The scholarship can be awarded for any program that is accredited by a post-secondary institution.

In order to and before being awarded the scholarship, the recipient must provide both proof of enrolment, and proof of payment, from the post-secondary institution.

At this time, once an applicant is awarded a scholarship, they are excluded from applying again for future such scholarships.

The topic for the 2017 UPCE Scholarship Program is: "Work-life Balance in Canada"

In order for your application to be considered complete and accepted, the following is required:

A completed application form, with all applicable sections completed. You must include your PSAC ID#, and your Local #.

AND (please check one of the following)

Option 1: a 500-word essay on the topic chosen by the UPCE for the current year. Your essay submission must be in Word or PDF format.

OR

□ Option 2: A YouTube video, info graphic, or audio recording/song on the topic chosen by the UPCE for the current year. Songs must be submitted on a CD labelled with your name, and you must include 3 copies of the labelled CD.





Completed applications must be submitted by mail (post-marked) by July 31, 2017, and be addressed to:
